The youths at the Walgwan Center are Aboriginal people between the ages of 12 and 17. They come from Quebec, the Maritimes and sometimes Ontario.

Under the authority of the Executive Director, the person will face the following challenges:

- Knowledge of the Office Suite software.

- Autonomous, structured, dynamic and enjoys teamwork.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills. Dedicated to the development of the child.
- Good physical condition.

- Will have to undergo a criminal background check, and road safety. Must have CPR certification and nonviolent crisis intervention certificate on probation.
